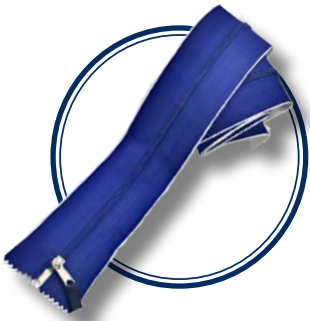

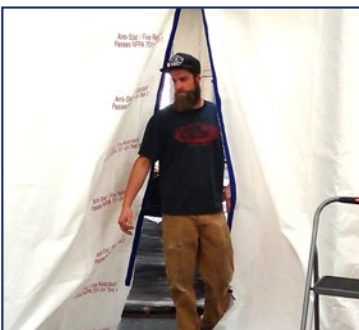
HEAVY DUTY SELF-ADHESIVE BACKED ZIPPERS



PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Self adhesive-backed zipper. New higher quality designed zipper affixes to plastic to create any size opening. Installs in seconds and opens from both sides, never coming in contact with the adhesive. Made in the USA.

Heavy duty adhesive EasyZip zippers provide the ability to create instant entry/exit from polyethylene enclosures, tarps or canvas. These self-adhering zippers can be quickly applied to create a doorway location of your choice and control the spread of dust and other contaminants on the jobsite.

- ▶ Heavy duty pressure sensitive high tack adhesive allows for repositioning during installation
- ▶ Adheres in a wide range of temperatures from -20° F to 150° F

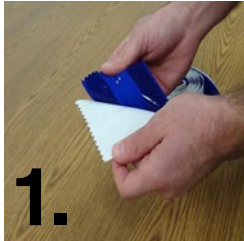

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



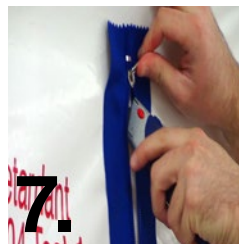
1. Peel off the white backing on the **BOTTOM** end of the sticker. This will be the top of your entry.



6. Once the strip has been placed, gently open the zipper from the bottom to the top.



2. Place and adhere this end at the top of the desired opening. Make sure that the bottom end of the strip aligns to the end of the sheeting you are adhering it to.



7. Once the strip is unzipped, make a perforation with a blade at the top of the desired opening.



3. Once adhered, continue to lay and peel the backing off of the zippers as you place the strip onto the sheeting. Gently press it onto the sheeting as you make your way down.



8. Continue to cut all the way down until you reach the end of the plastic sheeting.



4. Continue this method until you reach the bottom.



9. Once cut, press the two strips tightly onto the sheeting on both sides of the opening to ensure a secure adhesion.



5. Once you have reached the end of the strip, remove the backing and dispose of it.



10. Your EasyZip Zippers are now ready for use!
